<u>Sticky Group Discussion Questions for Sunday, December 7, 2014</u> Ruth's Decision Ruth 1

1. This Advent season we're reading a love story -- the story of Ruth. This story reminds us that salvation is not a cold, heartless transaction. No, God saves us because he loves us !

Begin your group session by reading and sharing your thoughts about these verses which tell of God's love : 1 John 4:7-11 / Ephesians 5:1-2 / John 15:9 / John 15:12-13

2. The key verse for the book is Ruth 4:14. Read this verse and discuss the following :

- What is a redeemer ?
- What does it mean to redeem something (or someone)?

Read about the Israelite laws of redemption which serve as a background to the story of Ruth. Discuss their significance to the story, and also how this part of Israel's law pictures the coming Savior.

- Leviticus 25:25
- Leviticus 25:47-49
- Deuteronomy 25:5-6

3. The book of Ruth is the only book in the Old Testament named for a Gentile. Why do you think God devoted an entire book of His word to a Gentile woman from Moab ?

God honored Ruth by making her the grand-grandmother of King David and an ancestor of Jesus the Messiah. What conclusions do you draw from this regarding God's attitude toward issues of race, culture, and ethnicity?

4. Ruth was driven by sorrow, loss, and adversity to follow Naomi to a new land, a new faith, and a new way of life. Looking back over your life, can you see instances where God used adversity to lead you to a new, positive place in life ? Explain your answer.

5. Re-read Ruth 1:16-17, the key to chapter 1. Ruth's decision was actually a 7-part decision :

- Where you go, I will go.
- Where you lodge, I will lodge.
- Your people will be my people.
- Your God will be my God.
- Where you die, I will die.
- I want to be buried in your land.
- Nothing but death will separate us.

What do you think drove Ruth to this level of devotion to Naomi?

6. What about your own decisions ?

- Have you decided that God is king ? ("Elimelech" means "God is king.") How is God king in your life ?
- Have you decided that there is pleasure in God's presence and in God's ways ? ("Naomi" means "pleasant.") How are God's ways pleasant to you ?
- Have you decided there is true love in God's presence. (Ruth is a love story.) How have you personally experienced God's love ?
- Have you decided you will go with, follow, lodge with, worship, and trust God? What challenges do you expect to experience along the way?
