Small Group Questions -Week of September 18, 2016

Intro- When can you recall feeling a sense of awe at God's handiwork? When do you recall starring up into the night sky?

- 1. Read Psalm 8:1-2. When have you heard children speaking the truth about life, or about the Lord? What can children teach us about faith?
- 2. Read vs.3-4. What are these verses saying? What happens when people see themselves apart from a Creator?
- 3. Read vs.5-8. According to these verses, humanity has been given tremendous authority... with authority come responsibility. What is mankind responsible for in regards to creation?
- 4. Read Hebrews 1:1-3 and 2:6-8. Discuss the ways these verses tie into Psalm 8.
- 5. What periods of your life were you dealing with self-identity issues? Describe the circumstances? How did things play out?
- 6. How might the opening and closing statements (v.1&v.9) add to the rest of the Psalm? How might this bookend truth help the flow of the content?
- 7. Looking over Psalm 8, which verse stands out to you and why?
