Christ's Victory Commands

Part 5: His Promise

Acts 23:6-16

- 1. Since Sunday's sermon had to do with goals and purposes in life, take time in your group to share answers to this question: "When you were younger, what did you think you wanted to be when you grew up?" How close have you come to that childhood dream?
- 2. Read the following passages of Scripture to get a flavor of Paul's purposes (calling) in life, and of the problems he was facing in Acts 23.
  - his call from God to take the Good News to the Gentiles
    - o Acts 20:24
    - o Galatians 1:15-17
    - o Galatians 2:7-10
    - o Acts 13:44-47
  - his desire to minister in Rome, the heart of the Empire
    - o Acts 19:21 (while on his third missionary journey)
    - o Romans 15:22-25 (written on the third journey)
  - yet, his heart for his own people, the Jews
    - o Romans 9:1-4 (note the intensity of his language)
    - o Acts 20:16
  - warnings not to go to Jerusalem
    - o Acts 20:22-23
    - o Acts 21:10-14
  - his arrest in Jerusalem
    - o Acts 21:27-36
    - o Acts 23:6-11

What must Paul have been feeling while detained in the Roman barracks?

Which of the following do you think you might have said to Paul if verse 11 were you speaking in place of the Lord?

- "Paul, you're worn out and need a vacation."
- "I'm going to see that you get a chance to relax."
- "Take courage; for as you have witnessed for me in Jerusalem, so you will also do in Rome."

Where, on a scale of importance, does Paul seem to place physical comfort, security, or safety? How important do we consider these things? Why are we different from Paul?

- 3. What would you say is God's purpose for people in general? What would you say is God's purpose for followers of Jesus Christ?
- 4. To what goal(s) in life do you feel God has called you? To what eternal ("kingdom") goals has God called you? To what goals has he called Emmanuel E-Free?
- 5. The Lord's promise in Acts 23:11 is a 3-part message : courage, commendation, and confidence.
  - What practical steps are you taking toward the calling God has given you, that you might win a commendation from him?

- How do verses like Acts 23:11 or Philippians 1:6 improve your confidence as a servant of the Lord ?
  How is this "take courage" command from the Lord a key to victory in life ?
